The Office for Harmonization in the Internal Market (Trade Marks and Designs) frequently receives queries as to whether the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No 40/94 of 20 December 1993 on the Community trade mark (CTMR) extends to certain territories which have special relationships with EU Member States. Therefore the Office together with the European Commission considers it useful to set out the situation under EU law for some of the relevant territories in the list below.

*According to information from the UK Patent Office, Community trade marks are recognized and protected without re-registration, inter alia, in the Isle of Man and Jersey. Extension of a Community trade mark may be applied for in the Cayman Islands. Extension of a Community trade mark is automatic in the Falkland Islands where the mark is also registered in the UK.

Please note that this protection is based on national law and not on EU law (it does not change the scope of the CTMR under EU law).
