





- Name
- Address
 - 1 <u>legal address</u>: where the party has its domicile, principal place of business or real and effective industrial or commercial establishment.
 - Address for service (optional)
- Country
- Nationality (RCDs only)
- Other: email/phone (optional)

- Legal practitioners (no change)
- Professional representatives (small changes)
- Annex I and II (ES, BOIP, UK removed)




