Acquired distinctiveness is a claim that can be made when registering a trade mark that is not distinctive per se but that has become distinctive as a consequence of its use on the market.

To be registered, a trade mark should be 'inherently distinctive', that is, it should be distinctive, non-descriptive and should not consist of words or signs that are customary in everyday language. However, as an exception to this rule, a sign can be registered if the applicant submits evidence of acquired distinctiveness of the mark by use. In this case, they will need to prove that at least a significant proportion of the relevant public perceives the sign as a trademark (i.e. that they identify the goods and services claimed in the application as originating from a particular undertaking). The Office will only examine the acquired distinctiveness of a trade mark when it is explicitly requested by the applicant, never of its own motion.
