




## **Application for Action**

### What is Application for Action?

- a form
- an act of will
- a tool





- NAFA all enforceable IP rights
- **UAFA** only IP rights that have an effect on the whole EU territory

Regulation (EU) No 608/2013 (Article 3)





## Legal background

Why Application for Action exists?

TRIPS Agreement

Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (Annex 1C of the Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organisation, Marrakesh, MA, 1994; Article 51)



provides data set

Regulation (EU) No 608/2013 (Article 6)

facilitates customs role



### **Applicants**

Who can submit the Application for Action?

- right-holder
- intellectual property collective right management body
- professional defence body
- group of producers of GI products (or representative)
- operator entitled to use GI
- inspection body or GI competent authority
- exclusive licence holder

#### **Data set**

What is important to input in the Application for Action?

- all mandatory fields (marked with \*)
- at least one of alternative fields (marked with +)
- contact details (applicant, representatives for legal and technical matters)
- IPR portfolio
- information about the goods (original and counterfeit) "we never..." & "we always..."
  - goods description and distinctive features
  - place of production
  - involved companies
  - traders & distributors
  - packaging
  - accompanying documents





#### **Channels of submission**

How can the Application for Action be submitted?

- in paper (handwritten)
- in paper (using PDF form)
- electronically (using EDB form) + in paper
- in future only electronically
  - using electronic form in the EDB
  - using electronic systems of the MS





## **Competent Customs Department**

Who will deal with the Application for Action?

- Competent Customs Department in EU MS
- list and contact details on DG TAXUD's web site

Regulation (EU) No **608/2013** (Articles 7 - 16)



- Who will use the data from the Application for Action?
- Customs risk management units
- front-line customs units

Regulation (EU) No **608/2013** (Articles 17 - 26)





#### Use of the data from AFA

How will customs use the data from the Application for Action?

- risk management (risk profiles)
  - goods description (tariff code)
  - provenance and route
  - involved companies & traders
  - goods clearance details



- packaging
- goods description
- distinctive features
- accompanying documents
- contact details
