This project is part of the Expand and Broaden the use of Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) programme tasked with implementing the initiatives foreseen under Focus Area 4 of the Boards of Appeal (BoA) Action Plan 2021-2026. The vision of the programme is to expand and broaden the use of ADR for IP disputes through the establishment of a Mediation Centre that offers accessible, added-value ADR services to users, supported by an optimal ADR ecosystem that ensures the highest standards of ADR service and mediator competencies, and that fully integrates the user and stakeholder perspective.

The objective of this project is the **design and first implementation of strategies for reaching out to ADR networks and stakeholders** in a structured manner in order to support the spread of the mediation culture and achieve the objectives of the Programme.

EXPECTED BENEFITS

- Raise awareness about ADR in general, promoting a mediation culture in the IP field
- Higher engagement and understanding of users and IP representatives
- Collaboration network with national IP offices and IP organisations
- An innovative and affordable ADR service for high quality dispute resolution
