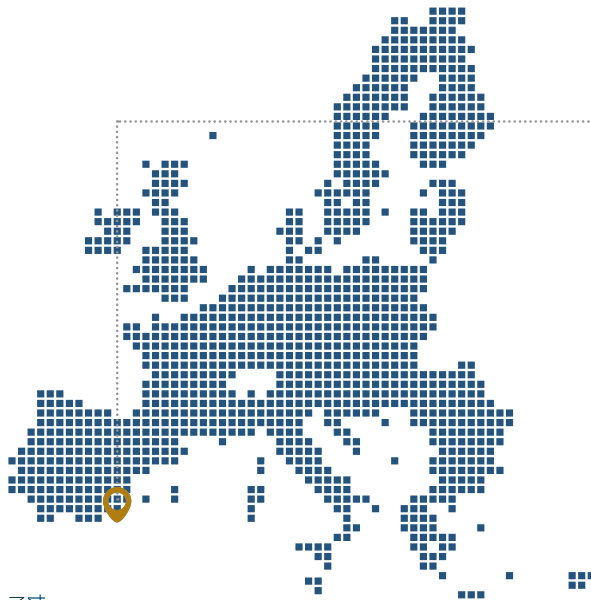

The European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) is the body responsible for managing and registering European Union trade marks and Community designs that are valid throughout the EU.

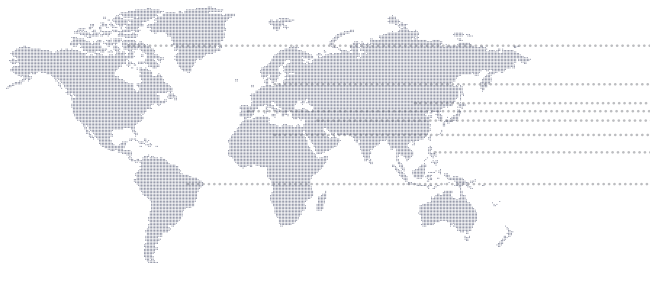
VISION

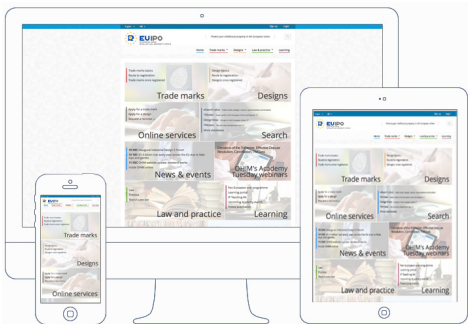
